Course overview

The course will focus on introducing students to the concepts associated with intellectual property and its legal implications in students' work and study. The following concepts will be discussed: intellectual and industrial property, the copyright laws and their protection in Poland and EU, and their practical implications in work and study.

The course consists of lectures and a project.

Content of lectures: Introduction to the concept of intellectual property and industrial property – contrivances, patents, trademarks - legal issues –case studies, the copyright laws and their protection in Poland and EU and their practical implications in work and study, protection of industrial property- workshops on preparation of a patent application and knowledge as intellectual property- workshops on preparation of a utility model.

Project: students in groups will prepare a “mock” (not existing) patent or utility model for the process or object indicated by the supervisor.

Outcome of the course

After this course the student should be able to:

- Prepare a patent and a utility model
- Understand and discuss the main concepts connected with intellectual and industrial property rights
